The Parish of Wantage


Wantage has two places where we meet to worship. The **Parish Church**, just off the Market Place, is a fine

medieval building dating to the 13th century, with a history reaching back to Saxon times. A daughter church, Holy Trinity, was established in Charlton in 1848. It recently underwent radical refurbishment, and has quickly proved to be a flexible modern space ideally suited for both worship and outreach.

The style of pastoral care, teaching and worship of the parish is rooted in the Anglo-Catholic tradition. You will find at the Parish Church a quiet celebration of **Holy Communion at 8.00am.** The Parish Mass is offered at **9.15 and 10.30am,** with all the usual ceremonial and a well-established musical tradition.

We offer Mass at different times and venues throughout the week.

The Parish Church is open each morning from **10.30** am until **12.30pm**.



The Parish Church was renewed 1996 and is used for a wide variety of activities including concerts and entertainment, feasts and fasts.

Arrangements for Baptism, Banns of Marriage and Marriage are made with Vicar.



At Holy Trinity, Charlton, there is a quiet Vigil Mass on Saturday at 5.00 pm. A Toddler Group meets on Monday mornings in the hall.

Council Information

Test and Trace grants

The government's Test and Trace Support Payment scheme is being extended to 31 March 2021. It had been due to end on the 31 January. This is the scheme that provides a £500 grant to eligible recipients if they lose out financially from having to self-isolate through the national Test and Trace system.

The cut-off time for applications has been increased to 28 days after the first day of self-isolation. This makes it easier for the council to administer and verify and it also provides a bit more time for people to submit their application.
