Psalm 27:1, 4-9 | Isaiah 9:1-4 | 1 Corinthians 1:10-18 | Matthew 4:12-23

This is the week of prayer for Christian unity. Can the cross bring people together? We need some-thing to. St Paul, whose conversion we'll remember on Wednesday, writes about "the power of the cross". The thriving church in Corinth had brought together an incredible variety of people, and yet to his dismay he's learned that there's a whole lot of factions within that community. He later re-minds them that together they're the temple of God's holy Spirit. The cross turns things upside down; it requires us to change our perspective, to "repent". It radically changed Paul. In relation to Jesus we are not separate units, but we are one body. Come, Spirit, change us - heal our divisions.
