Baptism of Christ

Psalm 29 | Isaiah 42:1-9 | Acts 10:34-43 | Matthew 3:13-17

On this Sunday we celebrate the coming of the wise men from the east to find the infant Jesus, and equally celebrate the baptism of the adult Christ at the start of His ministry. Although separated by thirty years, they are part of the same story. The showing of Christ's glory at the river Jordan, where Peter tells us that he was "anointed with the Holy Spirit and power", is — like his first Epiphany, in Bethlehem — for all the nations. As we enter a new year, let's thank Jesus every day that He has also shown us the glory of Emmanuel: God is with us all.
