Second Sunday before Lent

Psalm 119:1-8 | Deuteronomy 30:15-20 | 1 Corinthians 3:1-9 | Matthew 5:21-37

Jesus was faced with religious people who thought that sticking strictly to the rules in the Law of Moses, like Deuteronomy, would please God. But as the poet who wrote Psalm 119 realised it's a matter of the heart: "Happy are those who keep his decrees, who seek him with their whole heart". It starts with God's love for us and then our response to him. Discipleship is about relationship. The first of the commandments is to love the Lord God with all heart, soul, body, and mind, to be like Jesus. It's our response to his love. And then he gives the growth.

Our Make and Bake sessions for the Under 5's runs every Tuesday in term time, 9.30-11 am. No need to book, just £2 per child and everyone is welcome. A reminder that if you order any books online, one way of supporting us is to use https://uk.bookshop.org/shop/cornerstonegrove as we receive a percentage of the sales – you get free delivery on orders over £25. The Community Fridge is on every Thursday 4-5pm where anyone can pick up excess supermarket food for free. Finally, remember we do rely on everyone to use the Cornerstone as much as possible and more volunteers would be really helpful to enable us to keep going in these difficult times.


