Psalm 2 | Psalm 99 | Exodus 24:12-18 | 2 Peter 1:16-21 | Matthew 17:1-9

Before we launch into Lent, we're reminded just who it was that was driven into the wilderness "to be tempted by the devil," sharing our human experience with all its frailty. Our readings today are full of how Jesus shared God's glory. We are told, as he's transfigured on the mountain, "This is my Son, the Beloved; with him I am well pleased; listen to him!" Lent reminds us that we all have our wildernesses, times, short or long, when we're under pressure, tested to the limit and even far from God; yet still He says to us,

"Because of Jesus, you are my child, my beloved."
