## **Second Sunday in Lent**

Psalm 121 | Genesis 12:1-4a | Romans 4:1-5, 13-17 | John 3:1-17

I walk by faith, each step by faith," an old song used to say - which is what this week's readings are about. Abraham is our prime example of walking by faith. He "went, as the Lord had told him "Not knowing where he'd end up. What does faith mean? The song explains it, "To live by faith, I put my trust in You." As Jesus tells Nicodemus: "God so loved the world that he gave his only Son, so that everyone who believes in him may not perish but may have eternal life." In the end Nicodemus came to trust in Jesus. In this bewildering world, we need to trust Him too.
