We're in the ten days between Ascension Day and Pentecost, which for the first believers must have been a dark period of doubt. Perhaps they held on to Jesus' prayer for them. "I am asking on their behalf; I am not asking on behalf of the world, but on behalf of those whom you gave me, because they are yours... And now I am no longer in the world, but they are in the world, and I am coming to you. Holy Father, protect them in your name that you have given me, so that they may be one, as we are one."
