However, its effect was quite the opposite. It led to Christians leaving Jerusalem and scattering around the Roman Empire; as an early writer said, the blood of the martyrs is the seed of the Church. Both the churches at Hanney and Denchworth are dedicated in his honour. Jesus in the parable of the sower says the seed is his word which bears fruit and yields, sometimes x 100, sometimes x 60, and sometimes x 30, when it's listened to and understood. Let's listen!
