How would Jesus react to events in his homeland today? Would he have cried, as he did over Jerusalem, "How often have I desired to gather your children together as a hen gathers her brood under her wings, and you were not willing?" In our gospel Jesus tells a parable of a king arranging a wedding banquet for his son. Having been rebuffed by the original guests, he sends out further invitations and "the servants went out into the roads and gathered all whom they found, both bad and good." That's God's heart. He wants everyone, Jew and Christian, Muslim and faith-less, to share his kingdom of peace, justice and love – together.
