MY TRIP TO SOUTH SOUDAN (29th Oct - 9th Nov). **Geoff Maughan** joins a small team of trainers to visit a remote diocese of Nzara in South Sudan this week. They were invited by the local Bishop to lead a week-long training conference for 120 lay people who are learning how to lead small groups across the diocese. South Sudan is a Christian country that has separated from its larger Muslim neighbour to the north. Geoff and his colleagues fly to the capital Juba on the Nile before flying out with Mission Aviation Fellowship (in a small Cessna) to the western border near the Congo. **Please pray** for safe travel, a good conference and lots of active learning by participants.
