Sunday 10th December Second Sunday of Advent Readings selected from: Psalm 85:1-2, 8-13 | Isaiah 40:1-11 | Mark 1:1-8 | 2 Peter 3:8-15a

This Sunday the benefice celebrates St Nicholas (Santa Claus), the 4th-century bishop of Myra (near modern-day Demre in Turkey), to whom Challow's church is dedicated. He's considered the patron saint of sailors, unmarried girls, pawnbrokers, merchants and, most notably, of children. Today's news is full of heart-rending pictures of thousands of dead, maimed and orphaned children, the "collateral damage" of war. So let's pray in the words of Isaiah that the Prince of Peace "will feed his flock like a shepherd… and gather the lambs in his arms, and carry them in his bosom, and gently lead the mother sheep."
