### **Third Sunday of Lent**

Readings selected from:

Psalm 19; Exodus 20:1-17; 1 Corinthians 1:18-25; John 2:13-22

In Psalm 19 David uses four synonyms for God's word: "the law...the decrees... the precepts...the commandment of the Lord." Each of the 176 verses of Psalm 119 contains a synonym for God's word! Jesus is THE Word. After he cleaned out the temple traders, looking back, Jesus' disciples "remembered that he had said this; and they believed the scripture and the word that Jesus had spoken." A good way to understand the rest of the Bible is to check it by what Jesus did and said.
